KNOWLEDGE HUB

Check up on Winnipeg's local expertise with leadership and new developments in five key areas:

Infectious diseases

Winnipeg is home to the Canadian Science Centre for Human and Animal Health, the first facility in the world to have both human and animal Containment Level 4 labs under one roof, allowing for ground-breaking discoveries including the Ebola vaccine.

Cardiovascular science

Winnipeg's St. Boniface Hospital Research Centre's Institute of Cardiovascular Sciences leads the pulse on the fight against heart disease with its preeminent basic cardiovascular research and groundbreaking studies on women's heart health.

Chronic diseases

Innovations that are now globally accepted standards, such as a simple and reliable tool to predict kidney failure, were developed within the walls of our hospitals, including the Chronic Disease Innovation Center at Winnipeg's Seven Oaks Hospital.

Cannabis innovations

Winnipeg's Edibles and Infusions is one of only a few Canadian groups to successfully obtain a research and development license from Health Canada to produce pharmaceutical-grade quality cannabis edibles.

Biotechnology

Conviron, a company that provides plant-growth chambers and technology to the top government research agencies and AgBiotech companies in over 90 countries is headquartered in Winnipeg.

Did you know? University of Manitoba's own Dr. Magdy Younes designed and built "the Winnipeg Ventilator," which was a model for commercial ventilators found in tens of thousands of machines in ICUs globally during the 1990s and 2000s. The device is now being redesigned as a pandemic ventilator that could be manufactured and scaled up quickly and relatively inexpensively.


